Nominations

• Application procedure

All the nominated students should create an on-line account and follow the instructions to prepare the required documents (application form, learning agreement, copy of the passport, English language confirmation, ID photograph) which should be sent to the International Office of UWr before 15 th June (winter semester) and 31<sup>st</sup> October (summer semester)

#### DISABLED
