



**ANNOUNCEMENT
of the Dean of the Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Wrocław
of 20 September 2021**

**concerning the rules of conducting classes at the Faculty of Biotechnology
in the winter semester of the academic year 2021/2022**

Based on § 61 section 5 of the Statutes of the University of Wrocław and the Announcement no. 64/2021 of the Rector of the University of Wrocław of 29 June 2021 on the organisation of education in the winter semester of the academic year 2021/2022, it is established as follows:

- 1) Laboratory classes, seminars and conversation classes in all courses and years are conducted in a stationary form.
- 2) Lectures are conducted in a stationary form, except for lectures for groups of more than 50 people. In these cases, lectures can be conducted remotely (using MS Teams) or hybrid. Classes in hybrid mode is meant a combination of stationary and remote form - a lecture conducted stationary (with a limited number of people in the room) with the simultaneous remote connection with the other participants of the lecture using MS Teams.
- 3) First and second year undergraduate students work on research floors as part of their master's thesis. The requirement for individual research teams to maintain work schedules for staff, PhD students and students to control the maximum admissible number of people in the laboratories and ensure the safest working conditions remains in place.
- 4) Students, PhD students and employees who are in the Biotechnology Department building are required to wear protective masks. Surgical masks, FFP 1, 2, or 3 are recommended. During classes on the teaching floor, the mask should cover the mouth and nose at all times while participating in the class. Students, PhD students and employees on research floors are strictly obliged to cover their mouths and noses in passageways (corridors) and common rooms (e.g. equipment rooms), whereas when working according to the established schedule in the laboratory, in a situation when a distance is kept, it is possible to work without the mask.
- 5) Depending on the changes in sanitary and epidemiological situation as well as guidelines and orders of commonly binding law, the conditions of didactic organisation in the winter semester 2021/2022 may be subject to change.
