



**ANNOUNCEMENT no. 2/2021
of the Dean of the Faculty of Biotechnology of the University of Wrocław
of 3 December 2021**

**concerning the rules of functioning of the Faculty of Biotechnology
in view of the continuing state of the COVID-19 epidemic**

pursuant to the Announcement of the Rector of UWr no. 64/2021 of 29.06.2021 and the Ordinance no. 144/2021 of 29.09.2021, it is ordered as follows:

1. Laboratory classes and seminars in all fields of study and all years of study take place in a stationary form.
2. Lectures in groups of more than 30 students, from 6 December 2021 until further notice, shall be conducted in a remote or hybrid mode (the instructor shall discuss the form of the course with the students and inform the representative for teaching affairs).
3. Lectures in groups smaller than 30 people shall be conducted on a full-time basis, except for:
 - a) lectures whose participants are students of different years (*e.g.* elective lectures).
 - b) lectures included in the schedule between other lectures conducted in the remote mode (organisational reasons).
4. Foreign language courses and some physical education classes are conducted remotely in accordance with Ordinance no. 199/2021 of the Rector of UWr of 2 December 2021.
5. Students of first and second year of second-cycle studies work on the research floors as part of their master's thesis. In the case of volunteers, only vaccinated people are allowed to work stationary in the laboratories.

At the same time, the obligation for individual research teams to keep work schedules of staff, doctoral students and students in order to control the permitted number of people in laboratories and ensure the safest working conditions remains.

6. In the event of any symptoms of virus infection or contact with a person infected with SARS-CoV2, the following measures should be taken:
 - a) informing the instructor (if taking part in a stationary class);
 - b) consulting a general practitioner;
 - c) in the event of a medical indication for a SARS-CoV2 test, it is obligatory to inform the Vice-Dean for teaching or the Head of the Dean's Office.

7. In the event of confirmation of infection with SARS-CoV-2 virus:

a) the employee shall immediately inform his/her supervisor about the infection by email.

b) the student / doctoral student is obliged to:

- inform about the infection to the Vice-Dean for teaching (dagmara.jakimowicz@uwr.edu.pl) or the Head of the Dean's Office (marta.kolodziejczak@uwr.edu.pl)
- send information on SARS-CoV-2 infection generated from the Individual Patient Account at www.pacjent.gov.pl using the form <https://uni.wroc.pl/zglos-zachorowanie-covid19> maintained by the Occupational Health, Safety and Fire Protection Department.

A foreign student / doctoral student without access to an Individual Patient Account sends a scan of a positive SARS-CoV-2 infection test using the above form.

8. In the event referred to in pt. 7, the Dean may decide to:

- changing lectures and seminars to the remote mode for not less than 7 days.
- continuation/beginning of laboratory classes for a group of students with a case of SARS-CoV-2 virus infection, admitting only vaccinated people to the stationary form. The student presents the instructor with a certificate of vaccination, which is the basis for admission to the stationary classes (according to the Rector's Ordinance No. 144/2021).

9. An academic teacher / doctoral student teaching a group in which a case of infection has been found may be referred by the University of Wrocław to a SARS-CoV-2 virus test. For this purpose, please contact the Dean's Office.

10. Employees and students staying in the building of the Faculty of Biotechnology are obliged to wear protective masks (also during classes).
